The Church Leadership meeting was called to order at 6:02 pm by Lindsay Carrington. Opening prayer was given by Randy Smith.

Betsy Boaze, SPRC Chair gave us an update of the recent SPRC Zoom meeting with Chrisie Reeves-Pendergrass, our new Outreach Pastor. She and her family will arrive the end of June and her first Sunday with us will be June 28th. We are hoping to have a reception for Chrisie to welcome her to St. Matthew on that day if possible. Keep this family in your prayers during this time of transition. Betsy reported that Chrisie's office will be the present Conference Room and the present Library will become the new Conference Room and the Young Adult SS Room. That way she can be with the rest of the staff in the office area.

Blake Brookshire said that the Mission Committee had made a \$2,500 donation to United Ministries to be used during this time of the COVID 19 virus. Since the virus, IHN families are staying in motels so additional funds are needed for food, lodging etc. Blake has also used an additional \$500.00 from Missions for purchasing food items that are needed for the United Ministries Pantry. Blake is also working with a collaborative group that includes the YMCA, GCS, Well Greenville and the group You can Make a Difference, in an effort to provide food boxes to approximately 55 families who are living in motels in the Mauldin Road area. This group is using St. Matthew as a place to pack the boxes since the Caine-Halter YMCA is being used as a sort of staging area prior to deliveries to the motels.

Randy Smith reported that he has formed a committee to begin discussion on plans for when in person worship will begin. Their first meeting will be Wednesday, May 6th.

Jim Hopple reported that the Trustees are working on a recommendation for a fix to our HVAC system in the Family Life Center. There might need to be additional electrical changes in the Education Building as well. Jim is waiting on all the quotes and then a decision will be made.

Lindsay Carrington gave an update on the Federal Payroll Protection Program loan. We have been approved and the amount of \$61,800.00 will be deposited in our Sun Trust checking account very soon.
